This is my response to the Rule 8 letter giving notice of the Examination Timetable and other Procedural Decisions made by the Examining Authority.

Accompanied Site Inspection

I suggest that the Inspection includes the route of the proposed (Environmental Statement Volume 6.1 Chapter 2.3.56d) bound surface restricted byway, for use by cyclists among others, including (or also) the whole of the connecting route for cyclists between the retained sections of A303 West of the existing Longbarrow Roundabout and in the vicinity of the Countess Roundabout.

This part of the inspection should be detailed enough to inform the Panel of the directness (or otherwise) of the route proposed for cyclists (among others), its overall length compared with existing arrangements, its gradients, bends, corners and sightlines, and the locations of any stiles, gates, cross routes and any other obstructions.

I wish to comment on the Applicant's response to the Planning Inspectorate's s51 advice dated 20 November 2018, but I am currently unable to locate this.
