Notification of wish to speak at an Open Floor Hearing

I would like to register for this should there be any outstanding points I wish to raise.

Suggestions for sites to include in the ExA's itinerary

- Visit to Green Bridge 4. The view from Green Bridge 4 looking towards the western portal – how will this view appear once this road scheme is built. Have any visual images of this view been created.

- The view from the current A303 looking down onto the location of the deep cutting, especially in the location where the current A303 has been built up to above ground level. Have any visual images of this view been created to show the view from the downgraded A303 looking down into the cutting with the 4 lanes of traffic emerging from the western portal.

- View from the Lake Barrow Group and Bush Barrow from the Normanton Barrow Group – To understand that the WHS is not just about the Stonehenge monument itself, but about the whole landscape that shows all of our cultural development through the vast array of other monuments within the landscape. Due to the sensitive position of these locations numbers would have to be strictly limited and would need guiding in this sensitive landscape as it is within Normanton Down Reserve.
