Proposed development consent order

WRITTEN SUMMARY OF ORAL SUBMISSIONS FROM ISSUE SPECIFIC HEARING HELD ON 4 JUNE 2019 RELATING TO THE DRAFT DEVELOPMENT CONSENT ORDER

1. This is a short summary of the two points of clarification that were raised on behalf of the Trail Riders' Fellowship ("TRF") at the Issue Specific Hearing on 4 June 2019.
2. First, TRF asked for information about the temporary impacts from construction of the new A303 on byways, including their nature, extent and any mitigation measures. As is set out at footnote 6 of its Written Representations, TRF does not object to temporary impacts provided that they are appropriately mitigated. However, it is not clear from the documentation what is proposed. The representative for Highways England ("HE") confirmed that this information would be provided. TRF asks that it be provided in sufficient time ahead of the Issue Specific Hearing on 13 June 2019 in order to inform its participation at that hearing.
3. Second, TRF asked for confirmation about whether works to the existing A303 are understood to be development or associated development – principally Work No.6 (although similar analysis may apply to Work No.3). TRF notes that in its response to the ExA's question Tr.1.31, HE stated:

"... the changes to the existing A303 are brought forward pursuant to section 120(3) and Schedule 5 of the Planning Act 2008 [i.e. ancillary matters], rather than as 'associated development' pursuant to section 115 of the Planning Act 2008".

4. Whether or not HE is able easily to distinguish between all elements of the development set out in Sch.1 to the draft DCO, TRF considers that it should be able to be clear about the status of Work No.6.¹ HE again indicated at the hearing that it would do this. Again, TRF asks that this clarification be provided in sufficient time ahead of the Issue Specific Hearing on 13 June 2019 in order to inform its participation at that hearing.
5. TRF has produced this summary ahead of the formal deadline in order to inform preparation for the hearing on 13 June 2019.
