Application by Highways England for an Order Granting Development Consent for the A303 Amesbury to Berwick Down

Procedural Decision

We write to you to provide notification that the Examining Authority (ExA) has made a Procedural Decision to vary the Examination Timetable in order to assist the examination of:

- changes to the draft Development Consent Order (dDCO) proposed by Wiltshire Council (WC) and the Trail Riders Fellowship (TRF); and
- the draft Detailed Archaeological Mitigation Strategy (dDAMS).

Changes proposed by Wiltshire Council and the Trail Riders Fellowship

At the Issue Specific Hearing held on 13 June 2019 into matters relating to traffic and transportation (ISH6), the ExA heard evidence from a number of Interested Parties concerning changes to the dDCO proposed by WC and the TRF; including provisions which would amend motorised vehicle restrictions on specified byways. WC's and the TRF's proposed changes to the dDCO had originally been presented to the Examination in writing at Deadline 3 [REP3-046 and REP3-096].

In the course of ISH6 the ExA requested WC, the TRF and the Applicant to provide to **Deadline 4** in the Examination Timetable (21 June 2019) written submissions establishing their respective legal positions with regards to the proposed changes to the dDCO. The submissions were requested to include:

- views on the procedure to be adopted where changes to an application are not promoted by an applicant;
- views on the materiality of the proposed changes;



- views on the procedure to be followed if the changes to the application are regarded as being material;
- views on whether the Order Limits are of any relevance to the changes sought;
- views on implications for the Environmental Statement and the Equality Impact Assessment.

Separately, the ExA request the TRF to provide the drafting it would propose to be included in the dDCO to support its change request.

In making the above requests, the ExA committed to make a Procedural Decision to vary the Examination Timetable to allow for other Interested Parties to comment on the above submissions.

Consequently, the ExA now provides formal notification that the Examination Timetable is varied to include a new **Deadline 4a** (5 July 2019) by which Interested Parties are invited to comment on the legal positions established by WC, the TRF and the Applicant at **Deadline 4**.

Draft Detailed Archaeological Mitigation Strategy

The ExA has made a Procedural Decision to request for the Applicant to produce an updated dDAMS to be provided to existing **Deadline 6** (26 July 2019) in the Examination Timetable.

Consequently, existing **Deadline 7** (9 August 2019) is amended to allow Interested Parties to comment on the updated dDAMS provided by the Applicant to **Deadline 6**.

For completeness, the varied Examination Timetable is provided at **Annex A** to this letter.
