We note that my comments relating to agenda item 3.3 are in part surmised as follows: *Mr Sheldrake noted discussions on mitigation were ongoing, and assured the Examining Authority that a solution was certain.*

My statement during the hearing was 'certainly there is a solution out there.....[we] just need to reach agreement', which has been misinterpreted as '*a solution was certain*' which could be wrongly interpreted to mean that agreement is assured [for a solution].

As agreement for a solution has yet to be reached, we request that the summary is amended in this respect.
