Statement of Common Ground (SoCG) with Highways England

Highways England will submit an update report on status of the Statements of Common Ground at this Deadline. Discussions between the parties are ongoing and it is anticipated that a final, signed version will be submitted at Deadline 9.

Wiltshire Council's Legal Agreements with Highways England

Highways England and Wiltshire Council are making good progress with the draft legal agreement between the parties relating to highways matters. Only a small number of items remain outstanding and both parties confirm that they expect the legal agreement to be concluded by Deadline 9.

The Council is also in negotiations with Highways England regarding a Planning Performance Agreement. Whilst the principles for reimbursement of the Council's involvement, including a financial cap, have been agreed between the parties for the financial years 2016/17 to 2019/20, the agreement has not yet been finalised. Discussions between the parties also continue in relation to arrangements for post 2020. The Council will update the ExA at Deadline 9 as to its progress in finalising these arrangements, and hopes to be in a position to inform the ExA that this has now been signed.
