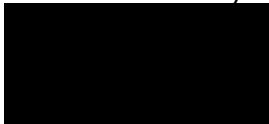
Application by Highways England for an Order Granting Development Consent for the A303 Amesbury to Berwick Down (Stonehenge) scheme

The National Trust has engaged with the proposed Scheme since its inception in 2014. Throughout the Examination process we have submitted a number of representations highlighting key issues which needed to be addressed to ensure the proposed road scheme achieves its potential to have a positive impact on the Outstanding Universal Value of the World Heritage Site. Our representations include an objection to the Compulsory Acquisition of land held inalienably by the National Trust required for the Scheme.

The National Trust and the Applicant have been in ongoing discussions concerning the Scheme. These discussions have resulted in sufficient resolution of the issues we have raised. Accordingly, the National Trust hereby withdraws its objection to the compulsory acquisition of land held inalienably by it, with immediate effect.
