#### 1 Introduction

- 1.1.1 On 27 September 2019 a Procedural Decision [PD-021] was issued by the Examining Authority in respect of eight proposed changes to the application (NMC-01 to NMC-08) put forward by the Applicant in its Proposed Changes Application [<u>AS-067</u>], and amended in relation to NMC-02, NMC-06 and NMC-07 as set out in the Applicant's Proposed Changes Consultation Report [<u>REP8-015</u>].
- 1.1.2 The Procedural Decision stated;

"The Examining Authority (ExA) has decided to accept eight changes to the application put forward by the Applicant, namely, NMC-01, NMC-02, NMC-03, NMC-04, NMC-05, NMC-06, NMC-07 and NMC-08. The ExA considers that the proposed changes represent non-material changes to the original application dated 26 October 2018. They are not so material as to constitute a new application and the development now being proposed is in substance that which was originally applied for. The Applicant is required to submit the requisite documentation in support of these non-material changes, as set out in the Proposed Changes Consultation Report (Non-Statutory) submitted at Deadline 8 (the Consultation Report) [<u>REP8-015</u>], by the close of the Examination".

1.1.3 This document provides a table identifying the application documents (including drawings) which have been updated to reflect the Examining Authority's acceptance of the non-material changes. The table shows which documents have been updated in relation to which of the eight non-material changes.
