As ground investigation surveys continue on the landscape to further understand the complex hydrogeology of the Scheme, we find it astonishing that the Secretary of State confines his requests for comments to the recent archaeological discoveries.

The water aspects of the Scheme are arguably as important, with the potential to cause devastation to the river Avon as well as many water abstractors within the area. However, the information from these ongoing surveys has not been published to the public and there is no opportunity for comments.

How can this Development Consent Order (DCO) be granted when the Examination Authority's did not have all the information present at the time of the examination?
