Dear Secretary of State for Transport:

I am writing to you regarding the A303 Amesbury to Berwick Down Development because I have very serious concerns about the project being implemented.

1. The Project **may** negatively impact the survival of undiscovered archaeological sites.
2. The Project **may** harm the flora and fauna and private water supplies.
3. The Project **will** severely damage a landscape that is considered the most archaeologically sacred land surface in Europe.
4. The Project **will** include at least 2 km of above ground road engineering within the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Stonehenge, Avebury and Associated Sites.
5. The Project's noise, vibration and lights during construction **will** adversely impact the Outstanding Universal Value as defined by the UNESCO World Heritage Site convention.

I implore you to deny the permits needed to implement this development.
