Dear Secretary of State for Transport,

I write regarding the A303 Amesbury to Berwick Down Development.

I have serious concerns about the project being implemented.

The Project will severely damage a landscape that is considered the most archaeologically sacred land surface in Europe.

The Project will include at least 2 km of above ground road engineering within the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Stonehenge, Avebury and Associated Sites.

The Project's noise, vibration and lights during construction will adversely impact the Outstanding Universal Value as defined by the UNESCO World Heritage Site convention.

The Project may negatively impact the survival of undiscovered archaeological sites. Several have been found in the last year or so - how many more lay waiting to be found...?

The Project may harm the flora and fauna and private water supplies.

I strongly urge you to deny the permits needed to implement this development.
