Dear Secretary of State for Transport:

I am writing regarding the A303 Amesbury to Berwick Down Development and I have serious concerns about the project being implemented.

- The Project will severely damage a landscape that is considered the most archaeologically sacred land surface in Europe.
- The Project will include at least 2 km of above ground road engineering within the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Stonehenge, Avebury and Associated Sites.
- The Project's noise, vibration and lights during construction will adversely impact the Outstanding Universal Value as defined by the UNESCO World Heritage Site convention.
- The Project may negatively impact the survival of undiscovered archaeological sites.
- The Project may harm the flora and fauna and private water supplies.

I strongly urge you to deny the permits needed to implement this development.
