STONEHENGE

It is great that the tunnel scheme has again been struck down.

Being able to see this World Heritage site, as one passes, has been a right of the people of this island since it was built. It also gives joy to the millions who admire it every year from the 303 especially foreign visitors. As an ex-diplomat I have often seen this, bringing people from Heathrow to Devon. Once the A 303 is in a tunnel, the only people who will be able to see Stonehenge are those who have the time (and money) to stop at the Visitors Centre for a conducted tour.

There is an obvious FAR CHEAPER solution. Leave the present road exactly as it is (with no excavations on either side) as the East → West dual carriageway of a dualled 303. The West → East carriageway (the view of Stonehenge from that direction is much less spectacular) should be built well away from archaeological remains to the north or south.
