Dear Planning Inspectorate

I ask the Secretary of State for Transport to turn down the application for the new road scheme at Stonehenge World Heritage Site.

He has asked for representations on a number of subjects including carbon emissions. Since the scheme was refused, the IPCC has published a new report making it clear that it is even more urgent now to take action to reduce carbon emissions. According to the report, 'Human-induced climate change is causing dangerous and widespread disruption in nature and affecting billions of lives all over the world, despite efforts to reduce the risks, with people and ecosystems least able to cope being hardest hit'. Any new Stonehenge road scheme would increase carbon emissions.

I am also very concerned about the effect the road scheme would have on the World Heritage Site.
