Dear Mr Shapps,

I am writing in response to the National Highways submission on the redetermination of Stonehenge. I do not think that National Highways has made any changes to the Scheme following the 2021 World Heritage Committee Decision; nor have they acknowledged that you found the impact of the Scheme on the proposed western cutting to be 'slightly adverse'. Furthermore, I feel that National Highways have fully assessed neither alternative routes that could have a lower impact on this World Heritage Site, nor alternatives to hard engineering solutions in improving access to the South West. Lastly, National Highways' submission has not updated the costs of the scheme's construction, or its carbon footprint.

In the context of the recent increases in concern for climate change issues and the Environment Acts 2021's new ambitions for nature recovery, I would ask you to reconsider the desecration of the World Heritage Site at Stonehenge once again.
