Subject: Redetermination of A303 Stonehenge scheme

Dear Secretary of State for Transport,

I note that you asked National Highways to provide additional information about the A303 Stonehenge proposal.

The response from national highways is in my opinion inadequate on several points.

Failure to change the scheme to reduce the risk that the site would be put on the danger list of world heritage sites.

Failure to update the carbon impact of the scheme or its alternatives. Given that the IPCC has now described the need to rapidly reduce carbon pollution as "code red", this is a critical omission and the scheme should not proceed unless a rigorous analysis of all possibilities have been explored to minimise the carbon impact of the scheme. This should include cancelling the scheme altogether so that the total carbon impact of the scheme can be compared with the status quo carbon.

Failure to explore alternative measures such as reducing road traffic, and other ways of improving access to the south west.

I trust you will refer the matter back to National Highways and request that they provide proper responses on these points.
