Dear Sirs,

I am writing to you regarding the National Highways response to your request for information and your subsequent request for comments on the National Highways response.

My key concern is the obvious point that National Highways has failed completely to take into account the 2021 decision of the World Heritage Committee.

Furthermore, the response from National Highways does not include updated information concerning the costs of construction for the scheme, and there is no update of the carbon assessment.
