I am writing as a member of the public who has both visited Stonehenge and used the road system around it and as a climate activist who is shocked that our government is ignoring science and its own Climate Change Committee by failing to take sufficient action to reduce carbon emissions.

I am deeply concerned that National Highways has not adjusted its proposals to take account of the 2021 World Heritage Committee Decision. Stonehenge is an iconic and unique site that needs to be protected for our own and future generations. National Highways should investigate measures to reduce traffic and improve access to the South West that do not negatively impact Stonehenge.
