Dear Planning Inspectorate

The planned A303 road scheme and tunnel at Stonehenge should be reconsidered and cancelled.

The scheme will destroy irreplaceable archaeological evidence , in and around the Stonehenge site even if a rescue dig is implemented.

The proposed scheme will increase car movements and therefore associated air and noise pollution. This cannot be justified within the new government commitment to a "Zero Carbon" agenda.

Given the above , the proposals do not represent value for money on any Cost Benefit Analysis basis and should be scrapped as soon as possible.
