I am writing to you re the consultation on Stonehenge. I am specifically concerned because the scheme put forward has not taken into account the 2021 World Heritage committee decision which given the importance of Stonehenge is not acceptable.

The proposed scheme by the Secretary of State will badly affect the site.

Alternative routes that would be less damaging and would reduce the impact on the world heritage site haven't been properly assessed or measures to reduce traffic and road emissions and improve access to the South West

Nor have proposals taken into account the impact of the IPCC report on climate change or the provisions of the Environment Act re nature recovery.

At a time when the impact of ignoring fundamental issues relating to Russia and Ukraine and our reliance on their gas and oil have been thrown into stark relief, as well as the impact of climate change, the thinking around Stonehenge needs to be firmly based on what is best to preserve this amazing site, not tinker around the edges so that it is not properly looked after for future generations.
