Dear Planning Inspectorate,

I was dismayed by the response of National Highways to objections to the proposed work in the vicinity of Stonehenge. It makes no concessions to the concerns of the public at roadworks which would be detrimental to an invaluable World Heritage Site.

Not only is the proposal at variance with the current call to limit environmental pollution but alternatives to the intended scheme have not been adequately explored.

I hope that you will ensure that this unique historic monument and national treasure is protected from the perceived needs of the moment when less damaging possibilities are available.
