**This email is to call for the following:**

National Highways to take full consideration of the 2021 World Heritage Committee decision and implement the changes proposed.  
Full consideration of alternative routes less damaging to Stonehenge, a World Heritage Site, eg southern route which would be cheaper. Longer tunnel in order to impact less on the site.  
Full carbon assessment of project in light of latest (Stage 2 - recent and 3 due out 4.3.22) IPCC reports, such that any new road scheme actually reduces carbon emissions rather than current proposal which would increase them.

Please re-examine the Development Consent Order. In my opinion the omission on current cost estimates, UNESCO's position and new information since the Examination closed in October 2019 are compelling grounds for a re-examination by an independent panel BEFORE the Secretary of State redetermines an application for a DCO for the very same road scheme.
