I have visited Stonehenge many times in my life when I lived not far from there and again on holidays. I also visited Avebury when it was almost unknown. Stonehenge has always been such a wonderful place showing what can be built in such an amazing way so long ago. I have followed with deep concern the proposed changes to the A303. My children – and now my teenage grandchildren – have visited the site and been amazed at Stonehenge!!

It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site – and MUST be protected.

<u>I therefore note that</u>: National Highways has not made any changes to take the 2021 World Heritage committee's decision to account. The cutting's impact as at present would be 'significantly adverse' as presently determined.

The longer tunnel is a MUST to preserve the setting.

I am therefore requesting a re-examination of the Development Consent Order
