Comment from a member of the public requesting a re-examination of the Development Consent Order before the Secretary of State redetermines the application.

I make my comments as a member of the public living locally. I am not expert in the planning processes involved, nor up to date as an engineer on dealing with the technical or cost aspects aspects of the proposed project.

However I would have expected that it would be transparent in the large volume of information presented for a lay person to understand what has changed in the proposals since last presented to the independent examiner, and in each aspect 'why' with proper justifications. A table would have given an appropriate overview.

The reports do not provide this transparency, either in general, or in specific terms in one area where I have more knowledge.

Consequently I request a re-examination of the Development Consent Order. This would mean re-examination by an independent panel with appropriate knowledge and expertise before the Secretary of State redetermines an application for a DCO.
