Dear Mr Shapps,

Please would you re-examine the Development Consent Order for the A303 road widening scheme.

Since the Concern for climate change has increased with the latest Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change report and there is a need to take urgent action to reduce emissions, not increase them as any new Stonehenge road scheme would. National Highways should work on ways to reduce road traffic, not simply widen existing roads which will inevitably have the result of increasing traffic, possibly negating any potential decrease in journey times.

I also note that Stonehenge is a World Heritage Site, so even if a widening of this road is thought to be necessary I would urge you to consider a longer tunnel in order to reduce the impact on the Site.
