To the Planning Inspectorate,

I am writing to ask you urgently to review your recommendations for the changes to the A303.

I am deeply concerned about the plans and the disastrous and irreparable impact that the proposed plans would have on this ancient World Heritage Site. It is also vitally important to remember that for many people this site is a place of great sacred importance, and must be respected and honoured as such. This site must be safeguarded at all costs. This is not a moment to cut corners for short-term perceived economic gain. Our ancient sites are priceless and must be preserved to the utmost of our ability for future generations.

In 2021 the Secretary of State found that the proposals would have a "significantly adverse" impact on the site. This is simply unacceptable.
