I am writing to voice my opposition to the planned A303 Stonehenge scheme. I am very concerned about the amount of carbon this scheme will generate in its construction and ongoing due to extra traffic using the road once built. We are permanently being told that the government is keen to reduce carbon however building new roads flies in the face of this ambition.
