Dear Planning Inspector,

I write to object most strongly to the road scheme proposed around and under Stonehenge.

The Secretary of State has said that the scheme is "Significantly adverse"

The World Heritage decisions of 2021 must be taken into account.

The Environment Act of 2021 sets out new and higher standards for nature recovery.

In the light of all this, the A303 road scheme must be properly re-examined and less damaging alternatives to road building must, and can, be found.
