Please accept the following comment:

There is little to gain and much to lose by introducing a road tunnel as a solution to the traffic problems at Stonehenge. It is a dangerous concept, ill conceived and a total waste of taxpayers money. It will do little to reduce congestion, but will simply move it down further to Chicklade and beyond.

It is also apparent that alternatives to the tunnel concept have not been given the same level of consideration, and political pressure has driven this project, bowing to pressure from English Heritage.
