I write as an interested person who has visited Stonehenge and viewed the site many times.

I am concerned that so far there have not been any changes that take the 2021 World Heritage Committee <u>Decision</u> into account.

The Scheme's impact on the proposed western cutting area was found to be significantly adverse

There are other options: a southern bypass route would be cheaper even if there might be some problems with it - what are your updated construction costs? A longer tunnel would reduce impact on site.

Please re-exam the development consent order. There are compelling grounds for this and it should be before the Secretary of State redetermines an application for a DCO for the very same road scheme.
