I read with alarm at the proposals to build a tunnel under the A303 at Stonehenge. This has been the subject of much debate since it was first conceived.

This is a world famous heritage site and should not be altered in any way at any cost. I have no idea why [REDACTED] insists this project should go ahead. He seems to want to ignore all the credible opposition and blunder on regardless. The only interested parties here are Mr Shapps himself and the contractor he intends to award this work to. I don't know of any one else who would approve of this.

No other country would even consider such a move on such an important site if it were in their country.
