STONEHENGE, Avebury and associated sites have been on the UNESCO World Heritage Sites list since 1986. It is in other words one of the original seven wonders of the UK .

I am neither an archaeologist nor a Nimby but an extremely concerned member of the public who is horrified by the proposed desecration of such an important archaeological site.

You should be maintaining the integrity of the site. Your tunnel proposal will do exactly the opposite and unless stopped, future generations will rightly condemn you for such thoughtless and indeed dangerous action.

In July 2021 Liverpool lost its World Heritage Status. It was removed from the UNESCO list due to what was described as ' *the irreversible loss of attributes conveying the outstanding value of the property* '.

We cannot sit back and watch the same happening at Stonehenge.

Please re-examine the Development Consent Order.
