I wish to object to the proposed Stonehenge tunnel. The tunnel would be only 3 km long, whereas the World Heritage site is almost twice that long.

It appears to me that National Highways has failed to make any changes to take account of the 2021 decision of the World Heritage Committee and failed to acknowledge that the Secretary of State found that the impact of the western cutting would be significantly adverse. There is no evidence that National Highways has given serious consideration to less damaging alternatives such as a longer tunnel or a different route.
