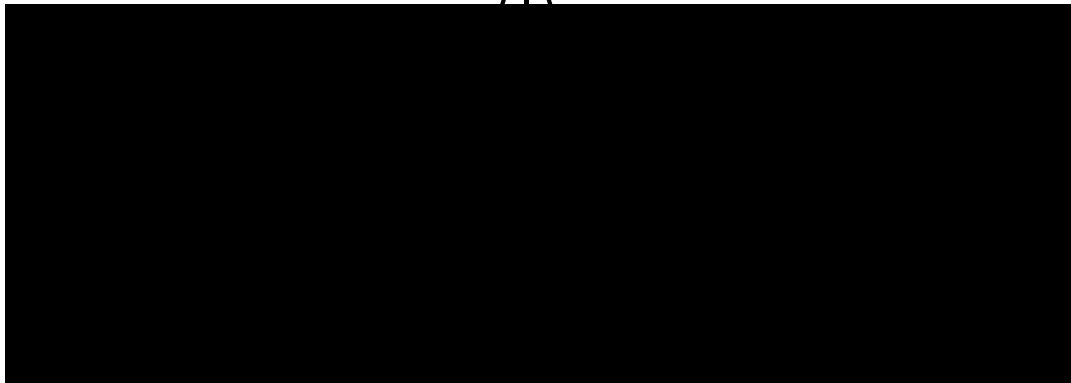

Whilst acknowledging that The Secretary of State found that the impact of the Western portal would have serious adverse impact National Highways has NOT made any changes that take The World Heritage committee decision into account.

Nor has there been a full assessment of Any/ All other alternatives including a Longer Bored Tunnel that does not have the same negative impact on the Stonehenge World Heritage site.

Nor have they updated, or taken into consideration, the run away construction costs.

This scheme, The Secretary of States decision and The Highways response have in my opinion been, ill thought out and rushed through.

This is not the time for such an ambitious 'Capital' project to be rushed through

with the changing needs of our environment and the Heritage needs of the locale being given such little regard.

All my previous submissions to this proposal and application and granting of permission stand as previously stated and have NOT been answered by this or previous assurances and I see nothing new that could possibly justify the proposals as they currently stand,
