There appears to have been no credible examination of the loss of archaeological record through the change to ground water patterns which will be caused by the tunnel and ponds. The vicinity of Stonehenge is the premier Mesolithic British site. The proposed tunnel is akin to destruction of the National Archives. It will destroy the main source of information about Mesolithic Britain.
