Please be clear that a re-examination of the Development Consent Order for the A3303 is absolutely necessary considering :

- the time lapse between the last application,
- updated current cost estimates
- UNESCO's opinions
- World Heritage Committee decision
- Secretary of State acknowledgment of "significantly adverse"
- Alternative options
- Up to date Carbon assessment
- Environmental Act 2021
- Climate Change

There are 9 key points there, each one alone holding significant value and weight arguably to cancel the scheme entirely but as a very very minimum to re-examine consent by an independent panel. Failure to re-examine the order by independent panel before the Secretary of State acts to redetermine the application would be a gross act of misconduct.
