Please re-examine the Development Consent Order!

The omission of current cost estimates, UNESCO's position, plus new information made public since the Examination closed in October 2019 are, together, compelling grounds for a re-examination by an independent panel to be undertaken very soon.

This should happen BEFORE the Secretary of State re-examines an application for a Development Consent Order for a plan that barely differs from the original.

A wider and more far-sighted approach to the issues and some creative lateral thinking need to be employed, before any plan is submitted for approval by the Secretary of State, the current plan being inappropriate for many reasons.
