- the Environment Act 2021 sets new ambitions around nature recovery. Please leave this area alone.

In my opinion the omission on current cost estimates, UNESCO’s position and new information since the Examination closed in October 2019 are compelling grounds for a re-examination by an independent panel BEFORE the Secretary of State redetermines an application for a DCO for the very same road scheme. Plus climate change, we need less traffic not more! This is an area of outstanding natural beauty and they want to destroy that. It needs to remain as it is.
