It seems to me that the applicant, Highways England, have agreed that a longer bored tunnel is preferable but that such an extension to the current scheme would not be value for 'tax payers' money.

It is my contention that Stonehenge is a World Heritage Site and of far greater importance than any consideration of cost effectiveness and that whatever damage is incurred far exceeds the need for any such improvement,

And that there is only one chance to get this right and that the present scheme as outlined by Highways is not of sufficient quality and that assurances given fall short of what is expected for such an important project.
