Dear Transport Secretary,

I am writing to object to this scheme. I agree with the conclusions of the Advisory Mission's report that the scheme would be damaging and a southern bypass should be further explored. At the very least, any tunnel should be extended to the WHS boundary.

The scheme goes against the recommendations of the Government's own advisers, the UNESCO World Heritage Committee and the views of the former Transport Secretary. The High Court judgment quashed the scheme because alternatives had not been properly discussed, and National Highways' response does not address this.

If you wish to proceed with it, I hope that there will be a formal public Examination so that all the evidence since 2020 can be discussed in full, and the Government's Planning Inspectorate can advise on it.
