Dear Minister

I have read the Findings and Recommendations from the report of the UNESCO Advisory Mission and agree with its principal finding, i.e. that the scheme would have an adverse impact on the World Heritage Site and that a southern bypass should be further explored.

The scheme is clearly unacceptable to:

- Government's independent specialist examiners,
- UNESCO's World Heritage Committee
- the former Transport Secretary himself who agreed with the examining panel that the scheme would be "significantly adverse" overall.

The High Court judgment stated that the Transport Secretary had not given proper consideration to alternatives.

National Highways' response fails to alleviate any of the above concerns.

I continue to object to the proposals and hope that the scheme will be abandoned.
