Stonehenge, with its thousands of years of unrivalled and irreplaceable heritage, is the worst possible choice to be made a victim of short-termism. This proposal is already publicly and comprehensively acknowledged as seriously flawed. Internationally recognised judgements show that if the Department pursues this course, it will be open to legal challenge. If the Transport Secretary and officials push it through, disregarding the existence of other, probably more site-sensitive options, they will be condemned down future years for causing irremediable damage to what is most valued, and valuable, in Britain.
