I have read the report of the Advisory Mission and agree with its principal findings ie that the scheme would have an adverse effect on the OUV of the WHO and that a southern bypass should be further explored. The Mission further admitted that at the very least the western limit of the tunnel should be extended to the WHS boundary.

National Highways have reiterated many of the arguments previously raised

To justify a scheme which is clearly unacceptable to :—

The Government's independent specialist examiners

UNESCO world heritage committee and

The former Transport secretary himself who agreed that the scheme

would be "significantly adverse" overall.

The High Court judgment quashed the ODC because the Transport Secretary had not given proper consideration to alternatives.

National Highways response fails to alleviate any of the above concerns and I continue to object to the proposals and continue to hope that common sense will prevail and the scheme will be abandoned.

Should the Transport Secretary proceed with the scheme I trust that this will be subject to another formal examination so that this may be fully and openly discussed by the government's independent planning directorate.
