Dear Ms, Trevelyan,

I write having read the report of the Advisory Mission and am most concerned on the detrimental impact of any road development near the WHS. A southern bypass might be the lesser evil but I am against the present proposals which have been rejected by UNESCO and your own Planning Inspectors. I regularly use the A303 travelling West and accept the very few occasions when traffic is busy crossing near Stonehenge.

If a more "open" road were created it would encourage heavy lorry use as an alternative to an M4/M5 route west causing further pressure on the A303 thus failing the intention of easing traffic flow.

National Highways has failed to recognise the real concerns of objectors but I trust that you will now reconsider the scheme.
