Dear Anne-Marie,

If we take solely the cost benefits of building the tunnel at its present location, or indeed at all. It simply is not worth doing. The World has changed dramatically since the announcement of the proposal.

With the new investment zone at Plymouth the flow of traffic on the A303 demands a wholly new route. Building tunnels is not solving the problem. Capacity up to the investment zone announcement would suggest go ahead, but now the flow is much greater and a Motorway is required. Thus the tunnel plans is utterly obsolete.

UNESCO is correct and I believe you can safely agree with them as the tunnel is now quite simply wrong.

No point approving yesterday's solution to today's opportunity.
