In response to the DfT letter of invitation of 14 September regarding proposals for the A303 between Amesbury and Berwick Down in Wiltshire I submit the following comments.

I have seen the Final Report on the joint World Heritage Centre / ICOMOS / ICCROM Advisory Mission to Stonehenge, Avebury and Associated Sites (c.373bis), and I write to object to the proposed tunnel scheme because of its adverse impact on the World Heritage Site.

No significant changes have been made to the proposed scheme since the previous Development Consent Order was quashed in the UK High Court.

The proposed scheme should be shelved and alternative solutions explored that will meet the approval of the UNESCO World Heritage Committee, independent examiners, local people and the UK public.
