I would like to make the following comments in support of the UNESCO concerns about the current proposals for this site.

Basically the site is so important as a World Heritage site and it still contains so many locations and opportunities for further archeological research that the proposed scheme to deal with the A303 issue must include no compromises in achieving full protection for the whole site.

I agree with the principle findings of the Advisory Mission report. The current proposals treat with contempt the status and professional competence of the bodies which have raised concerns about the current proposals. A full Southern bypass is the only way to save the site properly for future generations. At the very least a full public inquiry must be held to scrutinise the reports which have been submitted since 2020.
