Dear Transport Secretary,

As a British archaeologist I am horrified that the Government is continuing to press ahead with its scheme for a highly destructive tunnel. I have read the report of the UNESCO Advisory Mission and it is clear that the scheme would have an adverse impact on the OUV of the WHS and that a southern bypass should be further explored. This is a scheme which has been rejected by UNESC and, 5 planning inspectors, has outraged archaeological and heritage professionals, and which is extremely environmentally damaging. It would be highly damaging to our country's international reputation at a time when we are struggling.

Please take notice of all expert advice and reconsider this terrible scheme.
