### Summary of key points discussed and advice given

The Planning Inspectorate (the Inspectorate) advised that a note of the meeting would be taken and published on its website in accordance with section 51 of the Planning Act 2008 (the PA2008). Any advice given under section 51 would not constitute legal advice upon which applicants (or others) could rely.

The Applicant provided the Inspectorate with an update on the timeline of the scheme. The Applicant expects to submit the application on 21 September 2018. The Inspectorate informed the Applicant of the procedures to follow on the day of submission as well as what information might be requested before submission and during the Acceptance period.

The Applicant provided an update on recent engagement with stakeholders and noted that it intended to complete more work on the draft Statements of Common Ground before submission, although acknowledged that they were highly unlikely to be signed.

The Applicant outlined some considerations in respect of potential examination venues including venues in Salisbury, Amesbury and Winterbourne Stoke.
