The comments from the planning service from Cornwall Council are brief and relate to two main areas as we can see there has been ample involvement of other Cornwall Council teams in the process. Firstly, we are hopeful the Scoping exercise and subsequent Environmental Statement will address how local County roads can be traffic calmed to accommodate non-motorised users e.g. cyclists and horseriders. Our second observation relates to the use of land adjacent to the new road in particular at road junctions, and what controls would be placed on those to ensure appropriate development takes place. Relating to this issue is the potential opportunity that adjacent land could be utilised for the provision of Traveller sites as this is an important local plan objective.

We are grateful for your consultation to us and if there is anything else we can assist with please let me know.
